### **ALL AMERICAN POST**

For the second year in a row Post 981 has attained All American status, one of only 854 Posts out of 6,000 around the world.

Congratulations to former Commander Matt Voss and all the other members of our Post that helped us get to the top again.

### COMMANDER

As we move into the Fall season, I will start my remarks on a very sobering note: since our last newsletter this past Summer, we have lost 14 members due to deaths. In that same time period we have recruited 2 new members. One of the new members was an at-large transfer and the other was a new Life Member we recruited at the Legion 208 monthly meeting. Extrapolate these numbers over the next 12 months and you can see we have a definite membership problem. I recently attended a Commanders Call meeting where this issue was addressed, but obviously not solved. Our Post is doing all the right things, with little to show for our efforts. VFW National set a high bar for us at 176 (last year we never approached that number so I'm not sure how it was calculated). At this writing we stand at 162 members, or 92%. Department and National expects us to get to 102% in order to qualify for All-State and All-American, which means we need to recruit over 20 new members while not losing any more. Enough said. On the positive side, we recently received a \$500 donation for our Poppy Fund from a dying veteran, who is not even a member of our Post. We also received a \$50 donation from a relative of a World War 2 B-17G tail gunner who was shot down over

Germany in 1944. His remains were recently ID'd and returned. We prepared a nice certificate which was presented to the family.

Recently, we had recruiting booths set up at the Palatine Farmer's Market and the Buffalo Grove Farmer's Market, and we spent three VERY HOT days at Buffalo Grove Days, recruiting not only for the VFW, but for our American Legion partners. Results were mixed. Those of you VFW members are all qualified to join the Legion as well. Currently about 25 of our VFW members are also Legion 208 members. In theory, it could be 100%! Both organizations exist for the same reasons.

We have recently donated \$750 from our Poppy Fund to the Luther Home in Arlington Heights in support of their November 4 Breakfast for Veterans. Our donation was matched by Legion 208. The home recently lost their sponsorship for this event so the VFW and the Legion gladly stepped up to fill the void. If you haven't attended in past years, check it out - it's well worth it and FREE to Veterans.

Our Post has also been invited again this year to participate in Buffalo Grove's Veterans Day activities on November 11.

Our Senior Commander. Tony, has been diligently updating our Program Activity Reports (PAR - formerly called X-sheets). We are currently up to date. Tony is also working on a post-specific recruitment pamphlet and a new member pamphlet. We hope these will aid our recruitment efforts. Finally, back to membership issues. Wear your military hats and shirts often. I have personally recruited about a half dozen members at the local Jewel, Home Depot, etc. by engaging fellow

veterans. It actually works. It would be nice if each of our Post members recruited at least one new member. I know I'm preaching to the choir. Thanks for listening.

### FAREWELL MATT VOSS AND STEVE MACINNES


